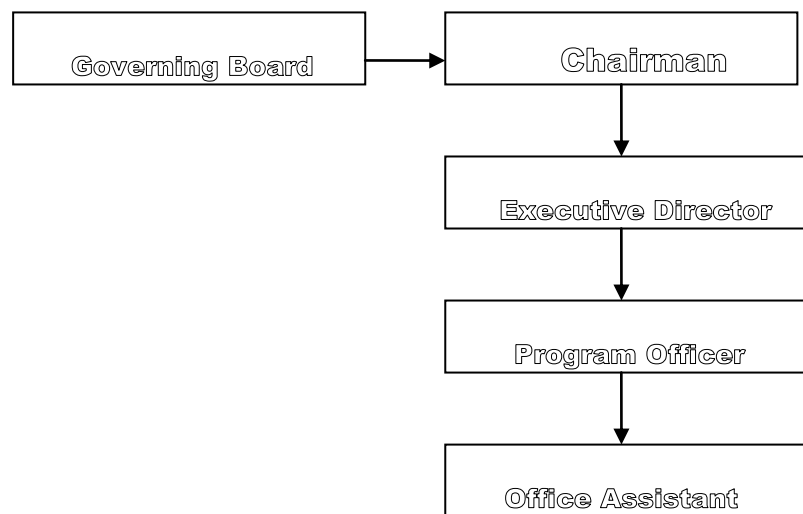


Information Manual In Accordance With Provisions Of Section 4(1)B

Functions and Duties of BITES

BITES is a non profit society set up by Government of Karnataka in co-operation with IT Industry and Educational Institutions, to promote education in IT. BITES works to promote and sustain the quality of IT education on a voluntary and self-financing basis. BITES strives to enhance education standards in Information Technology by disseminating information, and offering educational support services for updating IT skills.

BITES is registered under Society bearing the No. 208/2001-02 dated 12th June 2001. BITES conduct faculty development programs and distinguished lectures for BITES member and TEQIP institutions regularly once in a month. 4 1 (b) (iii) The procedure followed in the decision making process, including channels of supervision and accountability

BITES Governing Board consists of distinguished people from Academia, Industry and Government.

Governing Board manages BITES so as to promote its objects. It defines the policies, and procedures to be followed in line with its objectives, which has to be implemented by the Executive Director. It has full powers to add, amend, alter or abridge all or any of the objectives, rules and regulations of the BITES from time to time.

Board constitutes special sub-committees from time to time on need basis to conduct activities keeping with the objectives of BITES. These committees are not standing committees but are constituted for a specific purpose and wound up after the committees submit their report. The committee consists of members drawn from IT Industry and Academia. Following committees have been constituted by BITES so far.

BITES Best PhD thesis Awards committee to consider and recommend awards for best Phd Thesis in Electronics & Communication and Computer Science category.

The committee submit their recommendations to the board for review. Board takes appropriate decision which will be implemented by the Executive Director as appropriate.

BITES sends out a Need Identification Form to all its institutional members to identify the needs. The needs are consolidated and a program summary list will be prepared and sent to all corporate members for conducting workshops and guest lectures for sharing of their resource persons. Based on the information received an event calendar will be prepared announcing the programs which will be sent out to all board members and institutional members.

The Governing Board which is highest decision making body meets once in a quarter and reviews the action taken report of the previous quarter. It also examines the recommendations of the sub committee and decides the course of action to be followed for the next quarter and authorises the Chairman and Executive Director to implement the decisions taken by it.

The Executive Director liaises with the IT industries and Educational institutions to implement the decision authorised by the Chairman which are much pertaining to conduct of seminars, workshops, quizzes and guest lectures.

The Program Officer interacts with co-ordinators of the institutions to fix the schedule, venue and send out the request for nominations from the colleges.

The Office Assistant keeps track of the nominations by receiving faxes, letter etc and files them in appropriate files and maintains necessary records.
